Following his under and postgraduate studies at the University of Cape Town, Robert embarked on an 18 month spine fellowship in London. He worked under Mike Edgar at the Middlesex and Queen Square Hospitals, and Tim Morley, Ben Taylor and Jan Lehovsky at the RNOH, Stanmore.

On return to Cape Town he took up a consultant post at Groote Schuur Hospital where he established a spine service to deal with the overwhelming burden of spine trauma, infection and deformity in both the paediatric and adult population.

He has published both locally and internationally on trauma and infection work and participates in AOSpine, IGASS and SA Spine Society. He is currently president of the College of Orthopaedic Surgeons.

In 2012 he was appointed to the Pieter Moll and Nuffield chair of Orthopaedic Surgery as HOD. He continues to lead the adult and paediatric spine service.
