Annina Schmid is Associate Professor at the Nuffield Department of Clinical Neurosciences at Oxford University in the UK and a Consultant Musculoskeletal Physiotherapist. She obtained her Physiotherapy undergraduate training in Switzerland in 2001, completed a Masters degree at Curtin University of Technology in Perth in 2005 and a PhD in Neuroscience at The University of Queensland in Brisbane Australia in 2011.

Her research consists of a unique combination of both basic science and clinical studies, which aim to further our understanding of the pathophysiology of entrapment neuropathies with the ultimate aim to improve management of these conditions. Her recent work provides novel insights into neural regeneration capacity in the context of neuropathic pain.
