Radek Kaiser is a Neurosurgeon at the Military University Hospital Prague, Czech Republic. He graduated from First School of Medicine at Charles University in Prague and obtained a PhD in the field of brachial plexus injuries and peripheral nerves regeneration. His scientific results were awarded by several prizes. He completed one year fellowship in The Centre for Spinal Studies and Surgery in Nottingham and several short-term fellowships in neurosurgical and orthopedic departments (London, Glasgow, Vienna, Khartoum). Then he received board certification in neurosurgery in 2014. He has interest in surgery of degenerative spinal conditions, spinal tumors and trauma and peripheral nerves injuries. He is currently involved in various research projects focusing on biology of spinal tumors and surgery of spinal deformities. He has published a number of papers in international journals, a textbook on surgery of the cranial and peripheral nerves and lectured at national and international meetings.
