Mr Lester F Wilson FRCS is a Consultant Spinal Surgeon with Orthopaedic Accreditation. He trained in London and was a Spine Fellow in Nottingham under Professor Robert Mulholland. He has practiced at the Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital in Stanmore, London since 2003, dealing with complex degenerative disorders of the Lumbar Spine. In 2013 he set up the Regional Spine Infection service with the Microbiology Department.

His areas of Clinical Interest are Minimal Access Surgery for the Lumbar Spine, the Clinical use of Biological Materials in Spinal Fusions, Spinal Infection, and Revision Spinal Surgery. Since retiring from the National Health Service in 2016 he maintains a clinical practice in the Private Sector in North London.

He is a member of the British Association of Spinal Surgeons [BASS], and the Spine Society of Europe [SSE], and was a member of the program assessment team for Eurospine between 2010-2014. From 2005-2015 he was the UK representative to the International Society for Minimally Invasive Spine Surgery [ISMIS]. He gave the Magistral Lecture at the meeting in January 2013 in Zurich.
