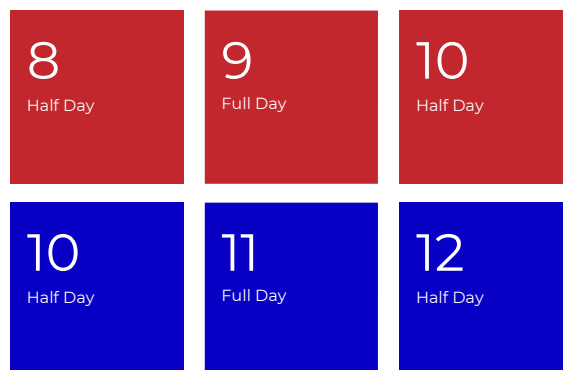

By Train

For a truly memorable journey, the Rocky Mountaineer luxury train offers an exceptional travel experience through the Canadian Rockies, stopping in nearby Banff. From Banff, it's a 40-minute drive to Lake Louise, with transportation services available.

By Car

The drive to Lake Louise via the Trans-Canada Highway (Highway 1) is straightforward and well-maintained year-round. The journey from Calgary takes approximately 2 hours, while travel from Banff takes around 40 minutes. Winter tires or chains are recommended during snowy conditions.
